- This could be a great option because if our memberships are honored at second gear club it could increase purchase of memberships for those who do only off-road. And more race entries.
- Could be used as a trial year, see how many entries etc. and re-evaluate next year
- Leave it with Off-Road for now. If they are all in favor then Ryan or Holly can bring to our board.

- Volunteers do earn a Free Membership. But some volunteers do earn above and beyond the membership.
 - Giving those members that go beyond giving some recognition with swag
- Options Made

- Talk about MX Committee members having a shirt because that is who you can go to for answers?
- Who would qualify?
 - Holly pulled out everyone who has twice the amount hrs. that are required for a "free" membership
 - Over 40 hrs. 11 Families or 18 Individual People using \$25 item = \$450
 - Over 50 hrs. Cuts numbers 9 Individual in ½ \$50 for item = \$450
 - Top 10 membership 11 People
 - Idea doing top 10 because next year number of hours for free membership. This way we would not need to re-evaluate the how to qualify who gets it.

 - Cassy motions that we order 4 orange shirts for Off Road Race Official. Mark Seconds. Morgan Thirds

 print Treasurer reports. Direct Export system

 - Would need to figure out how to mail keys or cards.
 - Could we do codes in the future? Need to figure out Day Passes
